Anchor Bay School District is committed to offering high quality Preschool and Childcare educational programs for young children through a variety of Early Childhood programs. We are proud to say that, as a PreK – 12 school district, we meet the needs of children and assure that the highest quality of standards are met. Whether you are looking for a full day program, a traditional preschool program or a specialized program, we have just what you are looking for. Here's a sampling of our Early Childhood Programs. With more materials and supplies than one can imagine, children are constantly challenged and being enriched with vocabulary enhancement, cognitive growth and socialization, as well as practicing and mastering fine and gross motor skill development. Preschool children are exposed to letter and sound recognition, basic math, science and technology concepts.

Full Day Preschool is available from 6:00am – 6:00pm. The program operates year-round with a session during the school year and another in summer (separate registrations) but is closed during holiday breaks. The *Creative Curriculum* is used throughout the day to promote child-initiated choices, cognitive development, social – emotional development and problem-solving skills. Our home-away-from-home environment provides a caring, loving, nurturing family-like atmosphere.

Traditional 3 and 4-year-old preschool provides children with hands on active learning experiences using the *Creative Curriculum* model that aligns with the Quality Standards for Early Childhood Pre-Kindergarten. Our outcome goals align with the Anchor Bay School District Kindergarten Standards making the transition to Kindergarten smooth. Our goal is to assure that children leave our programs prepared to be successful learners in Kindergarten.

Great Start Readiness Program is our State funded grant for eligible children to attend a high-quality preschool program four full days a week without charge. This program is primarily based on income for acceptance. However, a limited number of spaces may be used for a variety of extenuating circumstances. School bus transportation is available to Anchor Bay residents.

Time for Twos is a program that is designed for a parent to attend a planned play group with their two-year-old. Each week a parent and child participate in forming new friendships, playing games, making simple crafts, story time, and singing songs. Classes meet once a week through the school year.

Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE) is a high-quality preschool program for children 2 years-6 months through five years old who are delayed in speech, language, motor or cognitive development. Contact Special Education Department at 586-949-4513 for details and assessment.

Head Start provides children from low income families the opportunity for a Free Preschool experience. Contact either St. Clair County Head Start at 810-455-6482 or Macomb County Head Start at 586-469-5215.

Our **School-Age Childcare (SAC)** program provides before and after school child care for children in Kindergarten through 5th grade. A variety of games, crafts and special activities are planned each day for the children to choose from. This multi-age program allows siblings to be together before and after their traditional school day.

Summer Camp (Summer SAC) takes place from June to August. Children who have completed Kindergarten through 3rd grade will participate in a wide variety of activities, events, fun lunches and field trips. This is just another one of Anchor Bay School District's home-away-from-home experiences.
