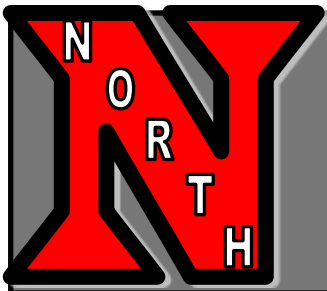


# Sailor Salute Program


Sailor Salute is a PBIS program. PBIS stands for Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports. It is a program designed to teach respect, responsibility, and safety at school. The program encourages good behavior by rewarding students for positive choices. Teachers and staff are trained to use positive communication with students to help prevent behavior problems. Students receive frequent reviews of the expectations and are acknowledged when they demonstrate them.

# Sailor Salute Rewards

	<b>What is it?</b>	<b>How is it earned?</b>	<b>When?</b>
<b>Reward Trips</b>	Reward trips reward students with good behavior throughout the school year.	Students earn trip with good behavior and not getting more than 5 demerit points.	There is one school wide trip to cedar point in May and one grade level trip to CJ Barymores in June.
<b>Student of the Month</b>	Reward program for students that go beyond expectations in both academics and behavior. Student receive a certificate and acknowledgement on our sailor board.	Grade level teachers nominate and vote each month on students.	Every month of the school year a student is chosen as Student of the month.
<b>Sailor Salute Tickets</b>	Sailor Salute raffle tickets are given to students from teachers who help contribute to the positive environment of our school.	Students who are spotted by staff members displaying considerate, honest, organized, responsible behavior or random acts of kindness are rewarded with a Sailor Salute ticket.	A drawing will take place during 6th hour every week to award winners.
<b>Cafeteria Rewards</b>	Lunch periods will be rewarded for good behavior, cleanliness, and conversation volume in the lunchroom.	Keeping the lunch room clean by picking up trash and cleaning lunch tables. Keeping conversations to indoor volume. Staying in seats and good behavior.	Winning lunch periods receive weekly prize of Sailor Friday. In addition a reward of a movie and popsicles for the best lunch period each marking period.
