



ACCREDITATION STATUS

All Anchor Bay Schools have met all requirements to be accredited by the North Central Association (NCA) Commission on Accreditation and School Improvement. The schools are now participating in the AdvancEd NCA process.

In 2002 the Anchor Bay Board of Education approved Education: YES! Michigan's school accreditation system is based on standards, and measures school performance and student achievement. Education: YES! and its national counterpart the federal No Child Left Behind Act evaluates schools and the school district based on rigorous academic standards using multiple measures such as the Michigan Education Assessment Program (MEAP) and the Michigan Merit Exam (MME) as parts of a system that will provide information guiding instruction.

One-third of the report includes the results of the building's self-assessment. These indicators measure a school's quality in areas such as curriculum alignment, staff development, family involvement, school facilities, arts and humanities education, and extended learning opportunities. Two-thirds of the report focuses on the MEAP/MME and student achievement growth over time. This chart reflects student composite grades and AYP Status for the 2007-08 school year.
