ATTENDANCE

Due to the acceleration of the night school program, **only two absences (6 hours)**, excused or unexcused will be allowed. On the **third absence** a student will lose credit and must be dropped from the class. In addition, tardiness will be monitored. Three tardies of 5 minutes or less will count as one absence. Tardiness of more than 5 minutes will be marked as an absence. There are no excused tardies.

Discipline

Minor Offenses

Discipline deals with behavior which is not considered appropriate for the educational environment the school is expected to provide. (Please refer to the Anchor Bay School District Code of Conduct for specific details.) Any repeated Minor Offenses is an automatic expulsion from the summer school program. **Tuition is Non-Refundable.**

The **minimum penalty for a minor violation** shall be the suspension of the student from his/her class or classes for the remainder of the day- resulting in an absence (1 day/ 3 hours) from that class.

The **Penalty for a repeated minor offense** shall be removal/ termination from the summer program with loss of credit and non-refundable tuition.

Major Infractions

The following list of behaviors are violations of the law and may be subject to criminal prosecution. Any Major Infractions committed during the summer program will result in an immediate expulsion from the summer program with a loss of credit and non-refundable tuition.

- Smoking on school property
- Battery

- Use or Possession of weapons
