Tuition Preschool Program "4 - year - olds"

4-year-old preschool classes are designed to foster each child's imagination, creativity and excitement for learning.

Children learn through direct, active, hands-on learning experiences that facilitate each child's overall development and readiness to be successful in kindergarten. Children are encouraged to experiment, problem solve, and take an active initiative in their learning environment.

Children will practice recognizing and writing their names, learning to recognize and identify the letters of the alphabet as well as the beginning sounds each letter makes. They will practice counting, one to one correspondence, patterning, sequencing and a variety of other hands on math activities. They will be involved in the active exploration of various creative art materials as well as music and movement. Children will be challenged daily with a variety of activities that are designed to meet the children's interests.

The Preschool experience provides a strong, solid foundation for success in school. Through ongoing observation and assessment the teacher's goal is to assure that each child is on target in acquiring the necessary readiness skills to be successful in kindergarten.
