Tuition Preschool

Our preschool programs provide young children with hands on active learning experiences that help prepare them to be successful learners in Kindergarten. The High/Scope Educational approach to learning and the Anchor Bay Early Childhood Core Curriculums are practiced to provide a high quality preschool experience.

Ages: Children who will be 3 or 4 years old on or before December 1, 2008.

Class Times: Classes meet 2 or 3 days a week for 2 ½ or 3 hours a day

Blossoming Fours (Michigan School Readiness Program)

This is a FREE program for children who qualify with "at risk" factors.

Ages: Children must be 4 years old by December 1st of the current school year;

Residency: Live in the Anchor Bay School district

Eligibility: Meet at least 2 identified criteria as defined by the State of Michigan as "risk factors"

Full Day Preschool/Childcare

This program is available Monday – Friday from 6:00a.m. – 6:00p.m. This mixed-age group of 3 and 4 year olds enjoy a full day curriculum that provides a time for lunch, extended outdoor play and rest. This program is specially designed to meet the needs of working parents. Weekly tuition includes daily preschool, breakfast, and two snacks.

Location: Early Childhood Center

Teens & Tots with Career Technical Education Students

This program meets Monday – Thursday at the Anchor Bay High School. Preschool classes are made up of children who will be either 3 or 4 years old on or before December 1, 2008, allowing siblings to attend together at the same time. High School students who are studying to work in the Early Childhood or Education field work directly with the preschool students under the watchful supervision and direction of a qualified preschool teacher and a career technical education teacher. This unique opportunity provides additional support, more one on one interaction and small group experiences. New for the 2008-09 school year, class times have been increased. Check the registration form available at Open House for morning and afternoon class times.

Location: Anchor Bay High School (6319 County Line Rd., Fair Haven)

Teeny, Tiny, Toddler Tars

This toddler play group for parent and child is held at the Early Childhood Center. Classes are held once a week for an hour and emphasize social skills and pre-literacy skills. Finger plays, songs, projects, stories and snack make the hour sail by. Every child leaves each class with a special book that they can take home to keep and parents leave with parenting tips on child development. Classes are limited to 10 toddlers ages 16 – 36 months and 1 parent.
