Teens and Tots Program & Career & Technical Education Program

Preschoolers in this program benefit from a qualified preschool teacher, a career technical education teacher and high school students who are studying to work in the Early Childhood or Education field.

Teens and Tots, "TNT" allows children to enjoy more one on one interaction and small group experiences. High School students work directly with the children in the early childhood classroom at the Anchor Bay High School under the careful direction of the teachers.

Children learn from each other through various play environments. In our multi-age classroom, younger students have the opportunity to observe, emulate, and imitate a wide range of competencies from older students. Older students not only learn and gain new skills, but have the opportunity to be role models for younger students. All of our students are presented a wide variety of activities in developmentally appropriate manners that allow them to grow and mature.

Children will practice recognizing and writing their names, learning to recognize and identify the letters of the alphabet as well as the beginning sounds each letter makes. They will practice counting, one to one correspondence, patterning, sequencing and a variety of other hands on math activities. They will be involved in the active exploration of various creative art materials as well as music and movement. Children will be challenged daily with a variety of activities that are designed to meet the children's interests while having the opportunities to practice sharing, taking turns, being away from mom & dad and how to interact and play "nice" with their "friends" at school.

Through direct, active hands on learning experiences, children will be encouraged to experiment, problem solve, and take initiative in their learning environment through active play situations.

A quality preschool class provides a strong, solid foundation for success in school. Through ongoing observation and assessment the teacher's goal is to assure that each child is on target in acquiring the necessary readiness skills to be a successful learner.
