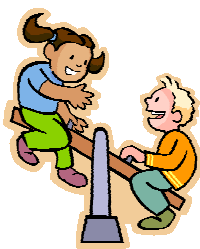

The Macomb County Health Department, in cooperation with the Michigan Department of Public Health, is conducting a preschool vision and hearing program in the Anchor Bay School System. The vision and hearing screening tests, when successfully completed, fulfill the legal requirement calling for either a diagnostic eye and ear exam or vision and hearing screening test after age three and a half and prior to initial entrance into school.
