The Accelerated Reader (AR) Program at Lighthouse Elementary awards prizes to children for reading books and taking reading quizzes. The program runs from October-May for 2nd through 5th grades, and from January-May for 1st grade.

The goals of the AR program:

- Increase students' reading and comprehension skills
- Motivate students to read more frequently

Basic information about the program:

- Each child proceeds at their own pace and reading level
- In the Lighthouse Library, AR Books are marked on the spine with a yellow sticker
- You can check out AR Books from the school library and public libraries
- Your family probably has some AR books on your bookshelves at home!

- AR quizzes can be taken only on the computers at school; in classrooms, the computer lab and in the library
