### *SCHOOL STARTS AT 9:06 AM*

Parents, please be aware that students are considered Tardy if they are not in the classroom ready to start at 9:06 AM. Students who are dropped off at 9:06 AM will be tardy since they need to stop in the office for a slip to get into class, go to their lockers, empty backpacks, etc. Please plan to drop off as close to 9:00 as possible using our safe parking lot procedures. See attached parking lot information for more detail.

### *PARKING LOT GENERAL RULES!*

1. **FOLLOW THE PARKING LOT PROCEDURES WHETHER OR NOT THERE ARE CONES AND/OR BARRELS SET UP!**
2. To prevent students from inadvertently chasing objects in the driving and parking areas, please ensure that all balls, balloons, yo-yos, etc., are tightly secured in backpacks or duffel bags.
3. Please explain these procedures to friends or relatives who may be substitute drivers from time to time.
4. When coming to school between 9:30 AM and 3:15 PM parking is permitted for a maximum of 10 minutes along the drive. **There is NO PARKING in the drive from 8:30 AM to 9:15 AM, and from 3:30 PM to 3:50 PM.**

#### A.M. DROP OFF

1. Drivers who are dropping off students in the drop off lane must enter the South driveway and **PULL UP** as far as they can. After drop off, stay in one lane and proceed off the premises or park in the main lot.
2. **DRIVERS ARE NOT TO EXIT THEIR VEHICLES WHEN USING THE DROP OFF LANE.** Parent volunteers will open the passenger doors.
3. Students must exit the passenger side of the vehicle.
4. Have the students ready to exit the car when it's your turn in the circle. If they are not ready, please use the parking lot for drop off.
5. **STAY IN ONE LANE.** Watch for drivers in the parking lane.

#### A.M. PARKING LANE / CROSSING AREA

1. **PARKING LANE** - for students who need assistance with backpacks or other deliveries. Enter the parking lane. Park your car.
2. Walk with students to the sidewalk. **Do not cut between cars and buses.**

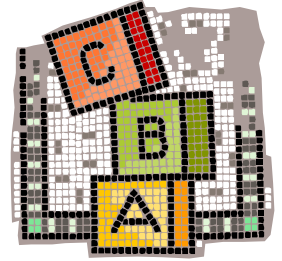
