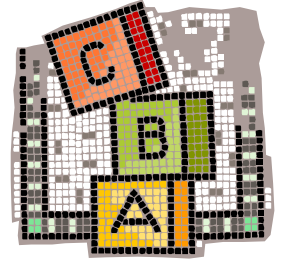

Naldrett Recycles!

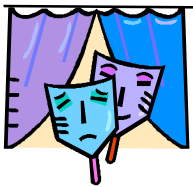
