

PRESCHOOL Information

The Michigan Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP) is a state-funded initiative offering free, high-quality preschool education for four-year-old children. Historically, eligibility was based on family income, but the program has now expanded to provide free PreK for all Michigan four-year-olds, regardless of income.



- · Age: Children must be four years old by September 1st of the enrollment year (or by December 1st if spots are available).
- Residency: The child must reside in Macomb or St. Clair County.
- Program Placement: Enrollment is based on eligibility factors determined by the Michigan Department of Education and Michigan Lifelong Education, Advancement and Potential (MiLEAP). Spots are limited.
