  - a. Have an idea where elements are located. Which elements are on the left side? Which are on the right?
  - b. Memorize chemical symbols (either one capital letter OR one capital and one lower case letter) for those 36 elements. Given a symbol (such as Mn), you should be able to identify the element (manganese). Given an element (such as arsenic), you should be able to give the correct symbol (As).
2. That's it! Do #1 often. Otherwise, enjoy your summer.
