<u>All</u> Anchor Bay High School 11th grade (Juniors) students will be taking the PSAT/NMSQT test this fall. This test can qualify your student for the National Merit Scholarship Program & other scholarships. The date of this state assessment is:

*Student rosters will be posted throughout the school this week.

<u>All</u> eleventh (11) grade students will come to school at the normal start time and report to the gyms for testing (lower-level; Main & Auxiliary Gyms). **Please know, all <u>Early College, Dual Enrollment</u> & any students not in the building daily have been contacted by ABHS counselors and are expected to test at ABHS on this day.** Testing will begin promptly at 7:17 am and conclude at approximately 10:45 am. Following testing, students will go directly to their 4th hour class or regularly scheduled lunch.

If your child is approved through College Board to receive accommodations, they will be contacted by school personnel with information on where to report that morning.

A DESMOS calculator is embedded in the testing program; however, <u>students are allowed to bring their own calculator for testing.</u> If your student(s) would prefer to utilize a school calculator rather than DESMOS, there will be some available on the day of testing.

*Please note that photo identification will be provided by ABHS.

There will be NO make-up testing. Any updates will be communicated ASAP.

IMPORTANT: Cell phones & smart watches are <u>NOT</u> permitted during testing. <u>Students</u> <u>should leave these devices at home, if at all possible.</u> If they bring them into the testing room, they must power off these devices, and student will not have access to them for the duration of the testing time. Any disturbance caused by prohibited devices will negatively impact <u>all</u> testers and could cause answer documents to become invalid.

No hats or hoods allowed.

Any food/drink brought on the day of testing will remain in the hallway for access during one of the break times.
